Textiles – Clothing (Tops, Sweaters, Dresses, Outerwear, Bottoms, Suits, Socks, Pajamas, Underwear), Footwear (Shoes, Sandals, Sneakers, Boots, Slippers), Accessories (Hats, Purses, Belts, Gloves, Ties, Scarves), Linens (Sheets, Blankets). *Items may be ripped, stained, button missing, broken zipper but....must be clean, dry and odor free.*

If paint can be cleaned up with water—it is not oil based (E-waste & Batteries—Bring to County Transfer Station for recycling)

Latex Paint (*Dry up and dispose in trash*)
Motor Oil (*Recycle at a Service Station*)
Asbestos
Materials Containing PCBs
Construction & Demolition Material
Smoke Detectors (*Manufacturer Mail-in*)
Commercial or Agricultural Hazardous Wastes
Non-residential Hazardous Wastes
Automotive Batteries (*Recycle at Retailer*)
Explosives, Flares and Munitions
Tires
Non-Hazardous Recyclable Materials
Unsorted Solid Waste
Radioactive Materials
Empty Aerosol Cans (*Put in Recycling Bin*)
Propane Cylinders / Tanks
Electronic Equipment -*no computers, TVs, etc*
